NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **LINDSEY MARSH DRAINAGE BOARD** propose to carry out improvement works on the following open and culverted watercourses in the Board's statutory district during 2017.

Works will involve the following:

1. The removal and replacement of existing culverts, installation of a new culvert and the construction of new manholes.
2. The construction of 1 no. headwall on an existing open watercourse.
3. The de-silting of the bed and re-grading of the bank of a 120 metre section of existing open watercourse including the construction of 2 no. headwalls. Work will be carried out on one bank only to minimise the environmental impact, following a technical and environmental survey.

Upon completion of the works, the system will be adopted by the Board.

The Board considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.

Any person or body who wishes to make representations to the Board in relation to the likely environmental impact of these proposals, must do so in writing to the offices of the Board at the address below within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
