Lindsey Marsh Drainage Board covers an area of 52,000ha that stretches from Gibraltar Point to the south of Cleethorpes in the North and back to the Lincolnshire Wolds. With a small, focussed team, we maintain over 900km of watercourses and operate 30 pumping stations.

The role will involve weed clearance of watercourses during the summer and reforming, improvement and construction works during the winter.
